Dear Senator Gooch,

Secretary Raffensperger told the Tea Party Patriots in Ellijay on March 3, 2022, that he will start an investigation into ballot harvesting once they have subpoenaed the whistle blower. The secretary has had information on alleged ballot harvesting for 15 months now. We are asking for you, our legislators to force an investigation into this matter. This can be accomplished by the **Senate** and/or **House Ethics Committee** – O.C.G.A. § 28-1-16.

Secretary Raffensperger facilitated Ballot Harvesting with hundreds of drop boxes, illegally issued ballots, and no investigations. Senate Bill (SB202) places the drop boxes in locked voting locations, to prevent ballot harvesting. Now the Secretary wants to put voter Registration data into the cloud. If the drop boxes aren't available to support fraud, the cloud will be. Please STOP Raffensperger from changing our voting systems to facilitate fraud. The legislators must act to take back control of our elections.

Secretary Raffensperger ignored our senate and house subcommittee findings from 2020 and 2021. Former Judge, then senator Ligon stated, *“The oral testimonies of witnesses on December 3, 2020, and subsequently, the written testimonies submitted by many others, provide ample evidence that the 2020 Georgia General Election was so compromised by systemic irregularities and voter fraud that it should not be certified.”* Three weeks later, January 6, 2021, Raffensperger sent a letter to U.S. Congress, allegedly to counter the fraud reports. We now know this letter to U.S. Congress had 42 false statements. Please STOP the lies and fraud.

Thank you for removing Secretary Raffensperger as the chair of the State Board of Elections. In his role as Chair of the State Board of Elections, Secretary Raffensperger made sweeping, poorly communicated, and inconsistently applied changes to critical elections procedures including, but not limited to: (i) permitting unsecure drop boxes whose number varied across the state, with some counties having dozens and others having none, and (ii) mass unsolicited absentee ballot request mailings, which unlocked the potential for fraud. The Secretary has fought, in court, every attempt by voters to audit our ballots. As my representative, please take every action possible to strip his election authority and return it to you or elected leaders. This must be done before the end of your session.
